REGULAR WEEKLY CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Creating an Artist Series – Artists often work in series, or work with one idea over multiple artworks, to fully develop an artistic concept and to bolster individual artist voice. Professional artist **Lado Pochkhua** will help students create and develop an artistic series, directing students in skill-building in different mediums (as necessary), and connecting them to other artists and artistic periods that will help them develop their own voice. Pochkhua specializes in printmaking and can also teach students that medium.

Oil/Acrylic Painting Studio – Walk through basic drawing and painting projects, for both experienced artists and ambitious beginners. **Requires a specific supply list**, including oil or acrylic paints, brushes, palette paper and canvas. All demos done in oil, though students can follow in **acrylic**

Learn to Draw – Think you can't draw? Learn otherwise in this all-levels drawing class, with particular instruction for complete beginners. All classes will feature a demo of a specific subject – and the teacher will walk you through the steps to create a better drawing than you can imagine. Throughout the year, demos might be conducted in pencil, charcoal and ink, but you can do every lesson with a pencil and paper. We've introduced a beginning drawing class for the India, Asia and Australia time zones on Saturdays, too!

Acrylic Painting – Think you can't paint? Learn otherwise in this all-levels painting class, with particular instruction for complete beginners. All classes will feature a demo of a specific subject – and the teacher will walk you through the steps to create a better painting than you can imagine. Throughout the year, demos might be conducted in gouache, watercolors or acrylics, but you can do every lesson with the water-based painting medium of your choice.

Watercolor Painting – Walk through the drawing and painting of various watercolor projects. Requires a specific supply list. Most projects will take more than one class period – one to draw the painting, the second to paint it.

Figure Drawing– Learn how to draw figures in this class, for both experienced drawers and ambitious beginners. Each week, the teacher will walk you through drawing the figure, with special emphasis on measuring and focusing on different aspects of figure drawing each week. Demos

might be done in pencil, charcoal, ink, pastels or paint, but each lesson can be done with a pencil and paper.

Soft Pastels – There is nothing like the vibrant color of soft pastels to excite the eyes and the artistic process! Learn the basics of layering, color mixing and applying color effectively in this all-levels class. Requires a specific supply list.
