



The Roaming Studio Supply List: Pencil, Charcoal and Ink Supplies

PENCIL

PENCIL SUPPLIES:

You can start classes with a simple hb pencil (the yellow ones we had in school), like this one, pictured here:



and any paper. It could even be printer paper.

Later, you can pick up a pad of any type of sketch paper, sized at least 9 x 12 inches, and pencils with different leads. You'll want a 2B, 4B, 6B and 8B (the higher the B numbers, the darker the lead).



CHARCOAL SUPPLIES:

- *Newsprint paper – this is soft and gray, like newspaper**
- *Soft charcoal – vine or willow, different sizes (note: do not get compressed charcoal, and no charcoal pencils – see pic for details)**

Good brands: Winsor Newton; Blick; Coates; Bob's Fine Vine Charcoal; etc.



- *Kneaded eraser**

Good brands: Prismacolor, faber-castell, general's etc.





INK SUPPLIES:

***Bristol paper, smooth – this is smooth, card-stock like paper.**

***Bamboo pen (Sumi supplies OK):**



***Bamboo sumi brush:**

Good brands: Blick, Yasutomo, Winsor Newton, etc.



***Waterproof black ink:**

Good brands: Higgins, Winsor Newton, Yasutomo, etc.
